- Over 400 individuals trained to date
- Twenty cities and school districts trained to date



Benefits

1. Furthers the District's efforts to reduce public water demand and usage. 2. A California friendly garden typically uses 30% less water than a common garden, and as high as 70% less water during hot, dry months. 3. California friendly plants are able to go without water for long periods of time, potentially saving 14,400 gallons of water annually per household during water shortages.
