A Flexible Strategy for CII Conservation

The Water Savings Incentive Program is a flexible rebate program for commercial, industrial and institutional water customers. Water customers can thereby receive water efficiency rebates that suit their specific needs. Participation in the program is accepted according to estimated water savings potential. Water savings potential is estimated by conducting irrigation audits, reviewing appliance and fixture inventories, and the use of other methods as appropriate to the site.

Large Landscape Irrigation System Upgrades
An estimated 23 million gallons of water is being
saved per year from irrigation system upgrades for
just three large landscape sites.





Industrial Facilities

By altering building cooling systems, and capturing condensate, the local Anheuser Busch brewery is estimated to be saving 21,000,000 gallons of water per year.



Institutional Food Preparation

Replacing two food steamers in two hospital kitchens with efficiency models is estimated to be saving 145,635 gallons of water per year, as well as reducing energy consumption.



Sensor Activated Faucets

A school whose students were leaving all bathroom faucets running at full force as a daily prank used the WSIP to fund the installation of sensory activated faucets.
