### City of Henderson

### City

- 104 square miles
- Population (2008): 269,826

### Department of Utility Services

- Employees: 277
- City department
- Primary Services

  - Wastewater

  - Conservation






### Water Resources

- 90% of Southern Nevada's drinking water comes from the Colorado River
- Resource has been significantly impacted by prolonged drought





1983 2007



### Conservation Considerations

- Located in the Mojave Desert
- Extreme daily temperature variation
- Average annual precipitation ≈4"
- New residents unfamiliar with water-efficient

landscaping

- Drought and Conservation Ordinance
- Site Visits
- Sprinkler Clock Demonstrations
- Jr. Water Watcher Program
- NO DRIP: Domestic audits and retrofits
- Turf Restrictions





### Why Turf?

60% of potable water use in the City of Henderson is attributable to outdoor irrigation

Up to HALF of that consumption is wasted water due to inefficient or poorly maintained

irrigation systems

Water used outdoors cannot be recovered by our system



## Landscape Restrictions

### **New Construction**

- No turf permitted in front yards
- <50% turf permitted in back yards</p>
- No turf permitted in commercial developments

### **Existing Construction**

- Turf installation prohibited in front yards
- Replacement of xeriscaping with turf prohibited





### Water Smart Landscapes Program

# Southern Nevada Water Authority (SNWA) Water Smart Landscapes Rebate Program

- Reduce water consumption by 50-70 gallons per square foot of turf converted
- Cash rebate per square foot of turf converted
- Beneficial landscaping requirements



### Barriers to Participation

# Up to 30% of program applicants withdraw from the process, many because of upfront expenses

- •Up-front cost: \$2-\$5 per square foot
- •Rebate received at project completion

Often results in inferior or cancelled conversion



### City Landscaping Assistance Programs

Home Enrichment Landscape Program

Redevelopment grants / low-interest loans

 Only available to low-income or redevelopment zone residents



### City of Henderson Vision

### Turf Removal Loan Program

- Facilitate participation in existing SNWA rebate program
- Provide assistance with up-front expenses
- Ensure that xeriscape conversions meet minimum standards



### Program Components

### 3-5-7 Plan

- 3% interest
- \$5,000 maximum loan
- 7 year deferred payment schedule
- Option to credit rebate to principal





### Applicant Qualifications


- Henderson resident / Utility Services customer
- Primary residence
- Meet minimum credit requirements
- WSL Rebate Program participant
- Six months to complete


