

Graywater - what is it?

Graywater comes from...

- Showers & baths
- ✓ Bathroom lavatory sinks
- Clothes washers
- It is NOT from...
 - ✓ Toilets & urinals
 - ✓ Kitchen sinks
 - Dishwashers

Huge Potential Savings

- Many systems attempting to penetrate marketplace BUT...
 - ✓ Not usually cost-effective (today)
 - toilet flushing costs only \$25 \$50/yr, maintenance costs
 - ✓ Declining graywater volumes
 - fixtures and appliances are becoming more efficient
 - ✓ "System impacts" upon drainlines and sewers
 - drain systems designed for high flows of yester-year
 - ✓ Public health & safety
 - patchwork of codes, regulations, official interpretations








- Brac system (Canada)
 - Being sold and installed in U.S. & Canada
 - ✓ Approved & permitted in <u>some</u> jurisdictions
 - Collect & filters graywater from shower & clothes washer
 - ✓ Filtered greaywater used to flush toilet or irrigate landscape
 - ✓ Compliant with IAPMO IGC 207-2006b and CSA B128-2006

Brac System



- Rewater Systems (U.S.)
 - ✓ Long history in the West
 - ✓ Captures, filters, & reuses water from clothes washer, shower, tub, & lavatory sink
 - ✓ Differences in codes affect application:
 - ✓ California: drip irrigate (subsurface only)
 - Arizona: drip irrigate (above ground permitted)
 - ✓ Elsewhere???
 - ✓ www.rewater.com/

- Perpetual Water (Australia)
 - ✓ Perpetual Water-Home[®]
 - Captures & treats water from lavatory sink, clothes washer, shower, & tub
 - ✓ Treated water used for toilet flushing, irrigation, car washing & general cleaning
 - ✓ Not yet available in the U.S.
 - ✓ Garden Angel
 - ✓ Water source: clothes washer
 - Captures, filters, & treats (phosphate removal, pH adjustment, disinfection, salt balance)
 - ✓ Delivers treated water to landscape suited to drip systems

Perpetual Water's "Garden Angel"

(clothes washer rinse water to landscape)



- Water Legacy (Colorado)
 - Bath & shower water captured, filtered,
 & disinfected
 - Treated water sent to the toilet for flushing
 - ✓ UV and hydrogen peroxide used for disinfection
 - No chlorine no odors
 - ✓ Compliant with IAPMO IGC 207-2009
 - ✓ http://waterlegacy.com/index.htm



Package Graywater Treatment Systems: the "to do" list

- Much potential, BUT....
 - <u>Must</u> complete more field tests of the systems in "real world" applications...
 - Pontos AquaCycle[®] system in various locations
 - Brac system in Washington
 - Perpetual Water system in California
 -in order to answer "savings", performance, maintenance & economic questions
 - <u>Must</u> resolve health code & equipment standards issues
 - NSF International Standard
 - IAPMO Standard
