WaterWiser History

1986-87 Discussions at AWWA ACE about dbase/info sharing
1992 Mid-winter WC meeting: consensus > need for a clearinghouse. EPA interest.
1993 EPA \$250K grant to AWWA: establish a Clearinghouse
1994 AWWA hired Clearinghouse Manager
1994 WaterWiser Steering Committe set > name, mission, scope of work

2001 AWWA assumed responsibility for WaterWiser2009 WaterWiser: Full Committee under WC Division



Why a WaterWiser Clearinghouse?

- * utilities fielding FAQ's drain on resources
- * hard to find program info/results
- * no easy way to share wc info
- * lack of prof info resources
- * EPA = include larger body of professionals
