G-Series Standard

- Utility Management Standard
- Stand alone document covering a major aspect of utility operation
- Upon Standard completion, a guidebook is developed
 - Sample templates
 - Standard operating procedures

Policies



G-Series Guidance

- Applicable to all sizes of utilities
- Applicable in all 50 States, Canada, and Mexico
- Achievable by most U.S. utilities without major expenditures
- Must include generally accepted practices
- Define minimum to achieve "good" utility performance



G-Series #480

 Purpose: To define the best practices for a water and wastewater utility conservation program.

 Best practices to include both operation and management components



G-Series #480

 Stakeholders: water and wastewater treatment and supply industry.

 Water and wastewater utilities, consulting engineers, treatment equipment manufacturers, etc.

- Review existing BMPS
- Programmatic or planning approach
- Develop a framework of minimum requirements
- Develop complete standard
- Complete AWWA Standard review process
- Approval by ANSI
