

Illinois Tollway oases operator faces \$83 million foreclosure suit

A lender has filed a foreclosure suit against a politically connected developer that operates the seven Illinois Tollway oases. iStar FM Loans LLC, a subsidiary of iStar Financial, filed suit in Cook County against Wilton Partners after the Los Angeles developer defaulted on an \$83 million loan to rehabilitate and manage the oases, according to the suit. Wilton won the 25-year contract in 2002, just before its owner became a major campaign donor to former Gov. Rod Blagojevich.



US Equities, the new management firm, started a new green initiative for their properties.



The Oases are managed and operated in-line with the best environmental practices, with particular attention addressed to improving water efficiency, enhancing indoor air quality, increasing recycling, utilizing green purchasing options and reducing energy usage.



- WMI was contracted by US Equities to complete a domestic plumbing retrofit program at the seven Oases Illinois toll ways throughout Chicago, IL.
- Restrooms at the toll ways service roughly 30,000 visitors every day
- Bathroom use accounts for over 48 million gallons in annual water use



- During the preliminary site audits various problems with the fixtures were evident.
 - Some of the toilets and urinals were short flushing and some of them would occasionally run on due to the valve sticking open and causing a continuous flush.
 - Additionally the sensor valves required frequent battery changes and were prone to problems with multiple flushing.



- WMI converted 273 toilets and 105 urinals to low flush and replaced sensor valves with manual flush valves.
- Project Cost: \$185,840
- Project Completion Time: 5.5 weeks
- The result was a savings in excess of 50%.
- The actual savings significantly exceeded the calculated savings.
