

#### City of Fort Collins, Colorado

- 65 miles north of Denver
- East of the Rocky Mountains
- Grew from 25,000 to 140,000 people since 1960s
- 15" precipitation per year

  - Three themes: innovate, sustain and connect






#### Sustainability a Core Value

- Utilities: Energy Efficiency, Water Conservation, Stormwater Quality



#### **Utilities for the 21st Century**

 Fort Collins Utilities is committed to delivering a high level of service to our customers in an environmentally and socially responsible way while making the best economic choices for the long term



#### **Water Stewardship**

- City committed to water conservation; supports regionally appropriate landscaping
- Xeriscape is not one particular style or look; it is the thoughtful process of creating a healthy, attractive landscape that conserves water





#### Sustainable Landscape Gaps

- Some City regulations sent a mixed message to citizens
  - Grass height
  - Parkway strips
  - Streetscapes

#### Varying Values: Lively Discussion

- Fort Collins is a "green" city with lush lawns & trees
  - Neat, tidy and attractive
  - Unnatural and inappropriate for our semi-arid climate
- What looks natural and diverse to one person is seen as signs of neglect and laziness to another
- Consensus: encourage a variety of landscapes that fit the character of our region and give citizens a choice to pursue their individual style



## **Grass Height Ordinance**

- City Code limited the height of grasses (except ornamental grasses) to 6 inches
- Citations issued for grasses exceeding the limit
- Some of these grasses are waterconserving and don't thrive with mowing





## **Water-conserving Grasses**


- Bluegrass needs about 1½" of water per week
- Blue Grama and Buffalograss need about ¾" every 2 weeks, about a quarter of the water
- Updated City Code to allow waterwise grasses (blue grama & buffalograss) to grow up to 12"





## **Parkway Landscaping**

- Parkway is the R-O-W between a residential street and the sidewalk
- Planning has encouraged bluegrass and street trees
- Xeriscape discourages grass in narrow strips
- Takes a minor amendment to change HOA landscape plans





#### **New Parkway Guidelines**

- Brochure and outreach with landscaping guidelines
  - 50% of area must be covered in live plant material
  - Line of sight for traffic or pedestrians may not be obscured
  - Recommended plant list
  - HOA can apply for minor amendment for the entire subdivision



#### Streetscape Standards

- Streetscape refers to visual elements and character for arterial street medians, roundabouts and parkways
- "Gateway" intersections are special
- Plan Fort Collins: "The city's streetscapes will be designed to contribute to the character, form and scale of the city."

#### Sustainable Landscaping

- Goal: create beautiful, sustainable streetscapes
  - More color and texture in landscape plantings
  - Add hardscape elements (railings, pylons, lighting, planters, walls, paving) for interest




#### **Visually Appealing Streets**

- More plantings to create a stronger and more beautiful visual statement
- Use medians as demonstration gardens for perennials, grasses and shrubs that reflect our regional character





## **Streetscape Rendering**



#### **Work in Progress**

- Finalize standards for arterial medians and gateway intersections
  - Compare costs for installation & maintenance of options
- Develop standards for irrigation design and maintenance
- Develop a Streetscape Plant List
- City Council approval of new Streetscape Standards
