Affordable local approach to reducing landscape water demand

 Knowledge in water efficient and sustainable landscape practices including water management and preservation of other valuable resources



- The Sonoma-Marin Saving Water Partnership is the parent Professional Certifying Organization (PCO) for QWEL
- EPA WaterSense labeled Professional Certification Program for Irrigation System Audits
- Recognition from the U.S. EPA WaterSense program with five awards in four years

SDCWA Program Implementation

- Approved May 2015 as part of Board's emergency drought response package
 - Second phase approved September 2016
- First phase January-December 2016
 - 15 class series completed
- Second phase January-June 2017
 - 10 class series completed





QWEL Training & Certification

- 25 class series completed
- 639 participated
- 568 completed program
- 79% earned certificate





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QWEL Highlights

- 99% felt the class provided them with skills and knowledge to manage landscapes more efficiently
- 98% rated the class as "good" or "excellent"
- Piloted Spanish-language training classes
- 173 entities represented
 - Suppliers, contractors and public organizations





Ongoing Implementation

- Recommend continuation of program
 - Consistent with regional "how-to resources" to advance longterm water efficiency
 - Fills important gap in regional training resources
- \$165,000 funding available from grants
 - Additional \$10,000 is recommended from operational funds
- RFP in process; will seek Board approval this fall




