




Gilbert Water Division produced **16,995,172,000 gallons** of water in 2016.

 - Current projections 305,000 population by 2040







 Conservation programs benchmarked against the cost of acquiring 100 year right to new water supplies (\$3500/ AF or \$10.74/ 1,000 gal)




2016 Gilbert Water Consumption by Customer Class

Water Wise Gilbert

- Non-residential water audit service provided since 2000 to Gilbert water customers
 - Lower participation rates than residential water audit service
- Created recognition component in 2015 called Water Wise Gilbert and also boosted outreach and recruitment to non-residential customer class



SERVING WATER ON REQUEST HOW MUCH DO YOU SAVE?

It's not just the water in the glass that is wasted if no one drinks it.

For every glass of water not served, as much as 3 gallons of water are saved.

But there's more...

Serve water upon request.

Serve water only upon request and ask before refilling. An 8-ounce glass of water will need an additional 16 ounces of water to clean the glass...plus the water needed for the ice! Every drop counts!



Don't thaw food under running water.

Thawing food under running water for just one hour a day can waste over 150,000 gallons per year. Plan ahead and defrost food beforehand.



Only wash full dish washer loads.

Fully load every rack you put in the dish washer. Partial loads can waste thousands of gallons! Also make sure to soak pots and pans and scrape dishes and cookware before washing.



Manage dipper well wisely.

Turn dipper well on only at first order, monitor the flow rate, and turn it off when its not in use or at the end of the day. A 0.5 gallon per minute well running 24/7 could waste up to 260,000 gallons a year!



Report all leaks immediately.

When looking for water-saving opportunities, fixing leaks is on top of the list. On average, leaks can account for more than 6 percent of a facility's total water use. Leaks often go undetected and can add up quickly.

In fact, it is estimated that minor water leaks in the U.S. account for almost 1 trillion gallons of wasted water each year. That's enough water for 11 million homes!

If you see a leak, say something quick!

The EPA estimates that introducing water conservation measures can cut restaurant operating costs by 11%.





Report constantly running equipment.

Reverse Osmosis

It is normal for RO Units to make a hissing sound directly after use; however, if the hissing continues for a long time or starts randomly, it needs service.

Water Softener

Water Softeners can regenerate automatically, manually, or at a defined interval. If you hear it running frequently or outside of normal run times, report it.

Toilets

If you hear a toilet running, report it. No toilet should run constantly and can waste over 20,000 gallons per month!

Drips

Drips may not look like a lot of water, but they can add up fast. One drip a second can waste over 3,000 gallons per year!

Constant Water Flows

From hot water heaters to drink machines, any equipment that is using water constantly is suspect and should be reported.




Development of the Scorecard

- ▶ Realization that monthly water use updates needed
- ▶ We learned the lesson from our HOA water budget program. Savings don't persist without constant reinforcement.
- Needed a time-efficient way to inform stakeholders on-the-ground of monthly water use (because most of the time, those with the ability to affect water use, don't see the bills!)




PM, and recent PM's of our large CNC machines, i.e. coolant change-outs. I think this past month's usage was mostly an anomaly, so it will be interesting to see what the next cycle comes in at.

As for the landscape water usage, the property manager had the water shut off about two weeks ago what with the rain events and all. Also, a new landscape management company is now under contract and is tasked with bringing water usage under control, so we'll find out soon enough the effects of this.


